The Lane Construction Corporation Announces New ‘One Lane’ Organization

(CHESHIRE, Conn.)—The Lane Construction Corporation is announcing its new organizational structure as it begins its 120th year.

“Lane’s tradition of integrity, commitment to excellence and sustained growth has helped our public and private customers reach their goals,” says **Robert E. Alger**, Lane President & CEO. “The new ‘One Lane’ organizational structure will better position us to serve our customers’ needs at a regional level for more success in the immediate and distant future.”

Lane’s Executive Team has implemented a new structure to better integrate Lane’s new direction that all construction solutions are available under one structural approach that prioritize serving our customer needs, complete with a Chief Operating Officer (COO), two Executive Vice Presidents (EVP), four Regional Vice Presidents (RVP), two Regional District Managers, twelve District Managers and four Assistant District Managers.

Effective Jan. 1, 2010, **Kirk Junco** will serve as COO, handling Lane’s overall operations, including 3,750 employees, 90 plants and 12 quarries in 20 states. **Mike Cote** has been appointed EVP of the North Division (north of N.C. and Tenn.) and **Dave Benton** will serve as EVP of the South Division (south of Va. and Ky.). **Scott Leach** is the new RVP for the Northeast region (Pa. north, including Ohio and Ind.) and **Farid Hamad** will serve as RVP for the Mid-Atlantic region (Ky. to Del.). **David Rankin** has been selected as the RVP for the Mid-South region and **Jim Hughes** has been tapped as the RVP for the South-Southwest region, including Texas.

A titan in the heavy civil and transportation industries, Lane constructs quality highways, bridges, locks and dams, mass transit and airport systems for public and private customers. Currently, Lane is a partner constructing the largest public-private partnership (P3) project in the United States (the Capitol Beltway HOT Lanes, valued at \$1.4 billion), and has been ranked by *Engineering News Record* as the seventh largest transportation contractor, second largest highway contractor and the 14th largest airport contractor in the United States.
