### **The Lane Construction Corporation Acquires White Brothers, Inc.**

(BANGOR, Maine)—White Brothers, Inc. has officially joined The Lane Construction Corporation.

“The Lane family welcomes Tim, Mike and the 50 employees of White Brothers, Inc.,” states Scott Leach, Lane’s Regional Vice President for the Northeast region, who has worked in the Bangor-area for his entire 27-year Lane career. “This is a great fit for both companies because we share many of the same values, especially an unwavering commitment to excellence, ethics and our employees. Additionally, Lane and White Brothers have solid reputations with their customers and the communities where they operate.”

The Lane Construction Corporation, which was founded in 1890 and is still family-owned by decedents of railroad engineer John S. Lane, officially purchased the 55-year-old, family-owned White Brothers, Inc. on February 18, 2010.

“Tim and Mike will remain involved in the Westbrook community and will continue to play a major role in overall operations,” adds Leach. “The acquisition provides them more resources to work with the community and customers in the Westbrook and Portland area.”

The transportation builder of choice, Lane constructs quality highways, bridges and airport systems for public and private owners throughout the State of Maine. Lane’s early work in Maine involved constructing sections of the Maine Turnpike in the 1940’s and building aircraft hangars at Loring AFB. Lane recently rehabilitated the Maine Air National Guard Airfield at Bangor International Airport and repaved several roads on Cadillac Mountain in Acadia National Park.

With the acquisition of White Brothers, Inc., Lane will employ just over 550 Maine men and women during the construction season and operate over a dozen facilities throughout north and central Maine.

Lane has never failed to complete a contract in 120 years. Ranked by *Engineering News Record* as the seventh largest transportation contractor, the second largest highway contractor and the 14<sup>th</sup> largest airport contractor in the United States, Lane is consistently recognized by the asphalt industry and statewide construction and environmental groups for its outstanding commitment to safety, the environment and communities.
